6. General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:

The Surplus and Deficiency Fund was established as a reserve to hold funds in the event the City could not meet a Local Improvement District bond payment. However, in 1997, the City established the Revolving Fund to make seed money available for LIDs, replacing the need for regular bond financing. The balance in the Surplus and Deficiency Fund was partially transferred in 2007 to the Revolving Fund but retained a cash balance of approximately \$400,000. This fund has not been used to meet bond obligations for at least 10 years. Also, the Local Improvement Assessment Revolving Fund, created in 1997, receives the assessments paid by district property owners on local improvement districts. Those funds are intended to be used on future LID projects. There is currently a cash balance of \$359,190.

This ordinance requests the transfer of the current cash balance of \$425,912 from the Suplus and Deficiency Fund (49000) and the cash balance of \$359,190 from the Local Improvement Assessment Revolving Fund to the Local Improvement Revolving Construction Fund (38081), and the appropriation of the funds to the Broadway Streetscape (Iowa to Wesley).
