The Industrial Waste Survey (IWS) must contain information on the specific use and type of wastes (industrial, domestic, etc.) generated and discharged to the sanitary sewer system of the subject building. **Denver Zoo's Response**

Operations in the waste management facility will include sorting and processing facility waste, which is a mixture of animal waste, concessions waste, grounds vegetation and general office waste. Generation of any liquid waste during processing from our facility waste material will be directed to sanitary sewer. Additional waste water streams may include condensate water from post material handling process equipment.
