- It is projected that the negotiated changes will not result in a change to the overall cost to the City to fulfill the obligations defined in the Collective Bargaining Agreement (2015-2017).
- Changes made to the method by which tracking, and the resulting compensation of Article 27.4 On Call has been agreed upon. Officers placed in "on call" status shall maintain a log which records actual calls during this status; and shall be compensated for each instance of active response; rounded up to the nearest 10 minute increment. Reporting and compensation shall occur each work period.
- The compensation of Article 20.1 Equipment Allowance, as it pertains to the acquisition, maintenance and repair of equipment shall increase from \$700.00 per year to \$875.00 per year.
