5. General description or background of proposed request. Attach executive summary if more space needed:

Ordinance no. 184, series 1992 established fund number 11804 (formerly 1191) for the replacement of specific City vehicles and equipment. Ordinance 1255, series of 2017 modified the fund name from the "Planned Fleet Replacement Fund" to the "Planned Fleet Fund" and updated the scope to include new and replacement vehicles and heavy equipment.

This bill request seeks to amend ordinance 184, series of 1992, as amended by ordinance 1255, series of 2017, to expand the scope to include costs that improve fleet equipment availability, including but not limited to purchasing parts, outsourcing for repairs, and labor for maintenance. The Department of Transportation and Infrastructure will work with the Department of Finance to determine how much of the Fund's capacity will be used toward these expenses.

This request is a companion to the annual Long Bill and allows for an administrative action needed to implement the 2026 budget as adopted.
