A RESOLUTION

Levying taxes for the year 2018 upon all taxable property within special districts within the City and County of Denver for purposes authorized by law for special districts.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That there is hereby levied for the year 2018 on and against all taxable property, real, personal, and mixed, within the following special districts a tax as indicated upon every dollar of assessed valuation to be collected at the time and in the form and manner and with like interest and penalties as other taxes are collected, to be paid monthly to the treasurers of said districts:

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1 **Section 2.** If any part or parts or subsection or subsections of this levying resolution shall be
2 held to be illegal or unconstitutional, such illegality and unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity
3 or constitutionality of the remaining parts of this levying resolution. The Council hereby declares that
4 it would have passed the remaining parts or subsections of this resolution if it had known that such
5 other part or parts or subsection or subsections thereof would be illegal or unconstitutional.
