Next Steps

- Temporary demonstration of full lane repurposing design.
 - Working with community work group on parameters and metrics.
- Assess real-time safety impacts and data.
 - Measure speeds, volumes, queuing, diversion, crashes, comfort, etc.
 - Conduct community surveys to gather feedback and perspectives
- Apply findings to next steps of demo deployment and final design.



Permanent Safety Improvements Regardless

Timing in tandem with demonstration construction

- Crossing flashing beacon (RRFB), refuge island, and crosswalks at Franklin and Alameda
- Virginia and Downing safety improvements (pedestrian signal timing, high visibility signals, and bulbouts)
- School zone signage and markings
- Marked crosswalks, medians and pedestrian refuge islands
- Reduced speed limit from 30 mph to 25 mph
- Protected bike lane approaches and green crossing markings along Washington and Emerson
- Spot safety treatments at Grant, Pennsylvania, & Corona
