7 **For an ordinance amending Section 18-95 to increase the number of positions the**
8 **district attorney is authorized to appoint**

10 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

11 **Section 1.** That section 18-95 (a), D.R.M.C. shall be amended by deleting the language
12 stricken and adding the language underlined, to read as follows:

13 **Sec. 18-95. - District attorney.**

14 (a) Positions authorized. The district attorney is authorized to appoint not more than ~~twenty-~~
15 ~~three~~ twenty-eight (2328) attorneys in the combined classifications of chief deputy and senior chief
16 deputy district attorney and have not more than ~~twenty-three~~ twenty-eight (23 28) being paid in those
17 combined classifications at any one (1) time and to have not more than twelve (12) attorneys being
18 paid in the senior chief deputy district attorney classification at any one (1) time.
