**A BILL**

**For an ordinance dissolving the Tennyson Street Pedestrian Mall Local Maintenance District and directing that the remaining funds thereof, after payment of outstanding expenses, be transferred to the General Fund in accordance with Denver Revised Municipal Code Section 20-211.**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 626, Series 1988, created the Local Maintenance District commonly known as the Tennyson Street Pedestrian Mall Local Maintenance District (“1988 LMD”); and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. No. 654, Series 1998, created the Local Maintenance District commonly known as the Tennyson Street II Pedestrian Mall Local Maintenance District (“1998 LMD”); and

**WHEREAS**, all maintenance responsibilities of the 1988 LMD have been assumed by either the 1998 LMD or other parties; and

**WHEREAS**, the creation and ongoing existence of the 1998 LMD has rendered the services that the 1988 LMD was intended to provide redundant and, to avoid a duplication of services, the City desires to dissolve the 1988 LMD and transfer the remaining funds of the 1988 LMD, following payment of outstanding expenses, to the General Fund in accordance with Denver Revised Municipal Code Sec. 20-211.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** That Council hereby finds that, to avoid a duplication of services, the 1988 LMD shall be dissolved and will no longer exist except as may be necessary to wind up business at the discretion of the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure of the City and County of Denver. Any funds remaining in the accounts of the 1988 LMD, following the payment of outstanding expenses, shall be transferred to the General Fund as provided in Denver Revised Municipal Code Sec. 20-211.
