The basic facts:

- 1. The increase would take effect January 1, 2020 and relates to the York Street site.
- 2. The increase would take the top rate (non-member adult) from \$12.50 to \$15.00.
- 3. This rate keeps us at the low end in the marketplace.
- 4. It has been over a decade since we increased our rates.
- 5. The addition of the Freyer-Newman Center will offer substantial new experiences and opportunities for visitors while at the same increasing operational costs.
- 6. We will retain discounts for seniors, active military and veterans, children and students.
- 7. SNAP recipients pay only \$1.00 for admission.
- 8. Members are free.
- 9. All visitors on free days are free.
- 10. We participate in the Five by Five program.
- 11. We accept the My Denver Card.
- 12. We participate in Urban Advantage.
- 13. We provide caregivers free admission.
- 14. Patients and families associated with the Ronald McDonald House receive free admission.
- 15. The Gardens provides free transportation and admission to underserved communities through partner organizations.
