Attach executive summary if more space needed: (who, what, why) The City and County of Denver is granted cable channels for Public, Education, and Government Access Television through the Cable Franchise Agreement with Comcast LLC. Denver Community Media (DCM) is the Public Access provider, Denver 8 TV is the Government Access provider, and through this agreement, Denver Public Schools/Emily Griffith Technical College (DPS) is the City's contracted Educational Access television provider. In addition to providing cable programming for channel 22 in the basic cable line-up, DPS also provides funding for the multimedia engineer FTE at the Community Media Center (CMC) and pays 50% of the City's common area maintenance costs for the space. The FTE position is shared by EGTC and Denver Community Media (a workforce development program owned and operated by the City) in exchange for EGTC's use of the CMC studios and classroom space for their multi-media and video production course. This Amendment extends the contract term through 2028 to align with the end of the current Cable Franchise Agreement. The Amendment also increases the total contract amount (revenue for the City) to \$841,503.
