Land Use Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

For an ordinance relating to the Denver Zoning Code correcting an error in the plant husbandry use in the I-MX and I-A zone districts.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined on the basis of evidence and testimony presented at the public hearing that the amendment set forth herein is in conformance with the Denver Comprehensive Plan, is justified because it corrects an error in a previous ordinance, and is reasonably necessary to the promotion of the public health, safety and general welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The Denver Zoning Code is hereby amended by:

- (a) Changing the Plant Husbandry Use, in the Agricultural Use Category of Section 9.1.4.5 (District Specific Standards), to show that in the I-MX zone districts, it is a Not Permitted Use (NP) and in the I-A zone district it is a Permitted Use with Limitations (L-ZP).
