The Colorado Coalition for the Homeless (CCH) Bridge Housing Program provides temporary housing to households with an identified housing resource. This program provides crucial support to these households in a critical time and ensures that they are able to successfully move from literal homelessness to permanent housing. Bridge Housing not only frees up capacity in our emergency shelter programs as these households who are close to housing are able to move out of those spaces but also provides households with individualized housing navigation and case management support to complete the last pieces in obtaining housing.

Scope of work:

- A. CCH will be responsible for adhering to the Shelter Program Standards document to be provided by HOST.
- B. Bridge to Home Program will serve highly vulnerable individuals and families experiencing literal or chronic homelessness, sleeping in places not meant for human habitation, such as streets, cars, and encampments.
- C. OneHome will be responsible for 50% of all referrals. All other referrals will come from other community partners including Denver Street Outreach Collaborative (DSOC).
- D. The Bridge to Home Program will primarily serve households referred through OneHome and outreach to encampments but may also serve individuals and families staying at an emergency shelter or safe haven, or fleeing, or attempting to flee domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, and/or other dangerous or life threatening conditions related to violence, who have no identified subsequent residence; and lack the resources and support networks needed to obtain other permanent housing.
- E. The Bridge Housing Program may serve individuals exiting homelessness from an institution such as a Colorado State institution, a hospital, jail or prison, a halfway house, child welfare or another institution, at risk of institutionalization, at risk of becoming homeless or for formerly homeless individuals who have been asked to leave their current housing environment and need a temporary safe place to stay while awaiting a new unit.
- F. CCH shall collaborate with the appropriate City agencies to offer accommodations for the temporary medical isolation of individuals experiencing homelessness who have been diagnosed with infectious diseases.
- G. Once Bridge Housing participants transition into their permanent supportive housing, clients will be provided ongoing case management, clinical counseling, and other supports to help them maintain housing stability. These services will be provided by CCH's Housing First, Residential Services, Family Support Services, or other service providers in the continuum with other funding. CCH may accept referrals for households receiving tenant-based subsidy (such as DOH HV) that have been evicted and may be at risk of returning to literal homelessness.
- H. Once Bridge Housing participants transition into their permanent supportive housing, clients will be provided ongoing case management, clinical counseling, and other supports to help them maintain housing stability. These services will be provided by CCH's Housing First, Residential Services, Family Support Services, or other service providers in the continuum with other funding.
- I. OneHome referrals will include only those participants who completed the Coordinated Entry Assessment.
