EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Warrant Cancellation Fee

The Court is requesting an ordinance change that would allow a \$100 nonrefundable warrant cancellation fee for those individuals who wish to cancel their warrant online or in person and be put back on the judges docket without being arrested and/or posting bond. This option would only be available to individuals who failed to appear at arraignment and their case does not involve domestic violence. It is estimated that 3,000 individuals would take advantage of this option each year. The benefits include giving individuals another option to clear their warrant without having to be arrested and fewer jail bed days.
