Parks & Recreation is seeking approval for a capital equipment purchase of a sprayer to support operations at the Willis Case Golf course. This purchase has become a high-priority and will be made in place of the greens mower that was approved in the annual appropriating ordinance, 1539, series of 2024. The existing sprayer at Willis is showing significant wear metals in the engine, however the engine manufacturer will not sell a new engine until the old one completely fails. The sprayer is one of a kind at all City Golf courses so there is no backup. The estimated cost for a new sprayer retrofitting from existing GPS parts is \$63,192.42.
