This work reflects a long-standing commitment to uplifting Native youth and ensuring they have access to culture, guidance, and opportunity.

In Denver, Bob is a co-founder of Indigenous Corporation 5280, a Native dance group formed to celebrate Indigenous traditions, promote cultural education, and build visibility for Native peoples in the metro area. Through performances and community events, the group helps preserve songs and dances while welcoming others to learn with respect.

Bob also serves as President of the nonprofit Red Hand Society, advancing advocacy, cultural empowerment, and mutual support for Indigenous families. Through leadership, collaboration, and service, Bob continues to honor community responsibilities and inspire future generations.
