Fair Elections Fund Technical Fixes

- This is a narrowly targeted bill to correct drafting errors in the Fair Elections Fund (FEF) Act. It
 makes technical fixes to maintain the intent of the voter-approved measure. No substantive
 changes to the program are included.
- By correcting a drafting error in the once-a-cycle inflation adjustment, the consumer price index (CPI) adjusted annual General Fund appropriation per resident will drop from \$5.00 to approximately \$3.45¹ for the next four years.
- The bill is estimated to save the General Fund \$1.1 million in 2025 which is not estimated to be needed by the FEF, and more than \$4.4 million over the next four years.
- The bill clarifies that the CPI adjustment to individual donation limits for candidates will be equally applied to FEF and non-FEF candidates.
- The bill also corrects a drafting error that omitted a section on the final version of CB22-1641, clarifying semiannual reporting requirements for candidates in 2024/2025 and aligning due dates with required ethics reports.
