**A BILL**

**For an ordinance making a rescission from General Fund Contingency, making appropriations to General Fund agencies, making appropriations in the General Fund to make cash transfers to the General Government Special Revenue Fund Series, and authorizing capital equipment purchases.**

**WHEREAS**, General Services requests \$2,200,000 to cover unexpected utility costs due to unforeseen usage as well as the addition of new buildings; and

**WHEREAS**, the District Attorney’s Office requests \$1,000,000 to support payouts and salary adjustments that resulted from significant turnover in the agency; and

**WHEREAS**, Technology Services requests \$700,000 in additional support for licensing and maintenance agreements to meet the continued costs of implementing citywide systems which the City has increasingly relied upon as it continues hybrid work; and

**WHEREAS**, the Denver Department of Public Health and Environment requests \$700,000 due to the addition of three positions in the Office of the Medical Examiner to address an increased workload and two positions in Denver Animal Protection to uphold the new regulations under the pit bull ordinance that passed after the 2021 budget was finalized; and

**WHEREAS**, the Office of Human Resources requests \$500,000 due to the addition of five unbudgeted recruiters and additional on-call staff that were needed to accommodate increased hiring needs Citywide; and

**WHEREAS**, the Denver County Court requests \$250,000 to cover increased costs of providing mandated services such as interpreters, competency evaluations, legal appointments, and other mental health-oriented services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Housing Stability requests \$45,000 to cover an Urban Youth Capital Investment that was budgeted in 2020 but not completed until this year; and

**WHEREAS**, Community Planning and Development requests \$1,000,000 to cover the cost to digitize approximately 11,000 files with official property and zoning use records because continuing to rely on paper records is a liability to the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the Risk Management Special Revenue Fund requires \$1,200,000 to replace totaled vehicles; and

1           **WHEREAS**, the Department of Parks and Recreation, the Denver Police Department, the  
 2 Denver Fire Department, and Technology Services are requesting a total of \$2,100,000 in  
 3 replacement capital equipment needs; and

4           **WHEREAS**, the Clerk and Recorder requests \$1,255,000 to redact personally identifiable  
 5 information in online records, as mandated by state statute;

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 8           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY**  
 9 **OF DENVER:**

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 11           **Section 1.** From appropriations heretofore made from the General Fund listed or indicated in  
 12 the following tabulation there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation  
 13 under the heading "Amount Rescinded" and transferred to the General Fund:
