In a performance audit of the Office of Telecommunications dated March 17, 2011, the Auditor expressed concern that the PEG fee has not previously been increased to the full \$1.00/month as authorized by the franchise. The Auditor also expressed concern about the prior custom and practice of the OTC receiving direction from a coucil committee on decisions of this nature, and implied that decisions to incrase the PEG fee should be made by the Council as a whole.

At least one council member has expressed concerns about this fee increase.
