To whom it may concern,

I'm a multi-skilled community leader who has worked as organizer, public speaker, facilitator, and graphic designer among other things. I have been involved in social justice work since I was a teenager. I would love to bring my many years in community organizing to the GES Coalition.

I started as a cultural and arts organizer and promoter in 2016 because I saw a lack of interest in these areas among the Latino and Hispanic communities. I created a group named ACEAL (Asociación Cultural de Escritores y Artistas Latinos), which is still active today. ACEAL organizes art, poetry and literature workshops, as well as book clubs and cultural events.

I then became a community organizer in 2014 in West Denver at Cheltenham Elementary School for school mothers and I also was part of the PTA and Padres y Jovenes Unidos.

Moving to the neighborhood Elyria gave me an opportunity to do more community organizing work. I became an activist and worked to stop one of the biggest projects in North Denver- the I-70 project. I started researching about the area, and got very interested in the environment and how it affects children, adults, the elderly and whole families.

Now I'm part of different groups and organizations that work with different issues in the Globeville, Elyria and Swansea neighborhoods. As a result of all the work I have done, there have been changes in Elyria and Swansea. For example, I started inviting the Police Department to the community to make them accountable and now we have their presence in our neighborhood. I have been invited to different events to speak and to be a facilitator. For example, I was on a journalist panel in the Society of Environmental Journalists in 2019 in Fort Collins. I was also part of a tour bus with journalists from The LA Times, the New York Times and other medias. Additionally, I was a speaker at the Centroamerica Festival where I presented the Civic Act which I introduced political entities from the City of Aurora.

Recently, I am working in two projects in Globville Elyria and Swansea neighborhoods. Ones is a Tree Planting Project, the other one is a Health Study which we have created a Community Council with residents that are going to be working with the specialists.

I am a person who takes things seriously and I know that every requirement must be taken with the same seriousness. I am also very passionate in everything I do and more when it comes to working for the community. As a woman and mother, I have had many difficulties, which have driven me to learn and study different courses to give my three children a better life and also to do more for my community and others. I hope that my resume demonstrates my ability to the job and I hope we can meet to talk about it. Thank you!
