

#### **Committee Consent Agenda**

for the week of Thursday, May 20, 2010

### **Bond Implementation Committee Staff: Gretchen Williams**

- BR10- Approves a \$2,608,210.10 contract with White Construction for the 0422 Sloan's Lake Park Marina Improvements project.
- BR10- Approves a \$3,181,698.30 contract with Golden Triangle Construction for phase one of the Ruby Hill Park Improvements per the master plan.

# **Economic Development Committee Staff: Shelley Smith**

- BR10- Adds \$4.5 million to the contract with Jacobs Engineering to continue work on airfield pavement on Concourse A & C and adds the contractor to the current City MWBE program.
- BR10- Amends the Airport Use and Facilities Lease Agreement between O408 Continental Airlines, Inc. and the City and County of Denver to reflect the airline's move of its gates from Concourse A to Concourse B.

## Finance Committee Staff: Debra Bartleson

- Authorizes the Manager of Finance to provide financing through a capital lease purchase transaction on behalf of Public Works to acquire 4 aerial bucket trucks. This ordinance request seeks approval to finance the acquisition of four bucket trucks through a capital lease purchase transaction on behalf of the Department of Public Works. The total cost of the trucks is \$747,700. Public Works has budgeted \$144,700 in 2010 that will be used as a down payment (payment in lieu of 2010 rental payment) and will only include in its lease payments the principal balance of \$603,000. Three (3) of the bucket trucks will be acquired from Transwest and a hybrid bucket truck will be acquired from OJ Watson. All American Investment Group (AAIG) will own the vehicles and lease them to the City, unless and until the City purchases them.
- BR10- Authorizes Public Works to acquire three (3) aerial bucket trucks from 0360 Transwest financed through a companion capital lease purchase agreement with AAIG. The total cost of the Transwest aerial bucket trucks is \$518,495.

# Neighborhood, Community & Business Revitalization Committee

- RR10- Appoints Janis McCubbrey to the DENVER ASIAN PACIFIC-AMERICAN COMMISSION for a term effective immediately and expiring January 22, 2012.
- BR10- Appropriates \$190,587 for the Emergency Shelter Grant Program for the program year beginning January 1, 2010. The Emergency Shelter Grant Program helps to provide essential homeless services.

# **Public Amenities Committee Staff: Gretchen Williams**

BR10- Appropriates \$55,000 from the Denver Golf enterprise fund balance for a structural assessment of Skeel Dam at the Wellshire Golf Course.

### **Public Works Committee Staff: Gretchen Williams**

BR10- Rescinds and reappropriates \$2,288,259.97 of existing building facility capital project budgets to consolidate budgets in conformance with 2010 facility budget appropriations in order to track the total amount of expenditures per facility.

BR10- Approves third year funding of \$1,340,700 to ACS State & Local Solutions, Inc. for the Photo Traffic Management Program.
