This contract provides for the continued use of approximately 70 acres at Daniels Park known as the Tallbull Memorial Grounds for cultural events and activities. This also codifies the use of other Denver Mountain Parks for collection of culturally relevant items by the TallBull Memorial Council. The first contract for this purpose was established in 1976. This contract will ensure continued access to land for traditional activities for Denver’s indigenous community and demonstrates the City’s commitment to honoring the Denver City Council Land Acknowledgement.

This contract establishes a renewed agreement between Denver Parks and Recreation and the Tallbull Memorial Council for the use of the Tallbull Memorial Grounds at Daniels Park and all Denver Mountain Parks, including long term use and access, facilities maintenance, grounds keeping, bison management, and traditional activities.

The Tallbull Memorial Council is uniquely situated to partner with the City and County of Denver at Daniels Park in a way that honors and acknowledges the tribal nations that have stewarded the land throughout generations. The long-standing relationship has been formalized through various contracts since 1976. The Tallbull Memorial Council has demonstrated the capacity to facilitate traditional cultural activities and events on behalf of Denver’s intertribal community and desires to continue to provide educational programs at Daniels Park. Many indigenous communities consider relationships to be a traditional value, and continuing to facilitate traditional land-use activities at Daniels Park recognizes and prioritizes these values.
