- 5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved**
 - a. Scope of Work**

Approval of a contract authorizing Sotheby's to assist the City and County of Denver, through its Director of Arts and Venues Denver, with the sale of four paintings by Clyfford Still, with all net proceeds of sale being remitted to the Clyfford Still Museum endowment, all as authorized and directed by the Order of the Circuit Court for Carroll County, MD issued March 24, 2011. The scope and terms of sale will be: (a) a private sale or public auction, (b) minimum net, reserve or guaranteed proceeds of \$25 million, and (c) a maximum selling commission of 15% of total sale price (inclusive of any buyer's premium) or \$15 million.

Generate sufficient endowment funds for the Clyfford Still Museum to ensure its ability to operate independent of any funding from the City and County of Denver for the foreseeable future.
