- The Wallace Foundation grant funds will be used to develop and launch a community-based data platform for the gathering of reliable information.
- The data platform will provide a regular inventory of programs and services, overlaid with Denver Public Schools' student outcome data and community and student demographics in order to identify gaps in services and inform programming and decision making across the city. Additional outcomes will include a long-term citywide strategy that includes sustainability for Out of School programming that meets the needs of Denver's children and working families.
- The city will align existing Out of School Time stakeholders to create a coordinating entity, the Denver Out of School Time Alliance, to serve as the driving force behind the use of data to address gaps in services and provide awareness of and support for quality Out of School Time learning opportunities.
- A commitment to quality will be embodied in the work of the Denver Out of School Time Alliance, who will work to deepen program quality by expanding the use of the Youth Program Quality Intervention tool across the city.

Employees/contractors at the Mayor's Office for Education and Children, Denver Public Schools and Civic Canopy will staff this grant.

The cash match requirement for this grant will be provided the Denver Public Schools Foundation, Piton Foundation, Tim and Bernadette Marquez Foundation, and the Lights on Afterschool Partnership. In-kind match commitments have been pledged Denver Public Schools, Mayor's Office for Education and Children, and CiviCore.
