5 **A BILL**

6 **For an ordinance approving a proposed Intergovernmental Agreement between**
7 **the City and County of Denver and State of Colorado, to administer the FY19-20**
8 **community corrections program that provides residential and non-residential**
9 **services to offenders, changing the budget basis of the Community Corrections**
10 **Special Revenue Fund, and making appropriations.**

11 **WHEREAS**, the Community Corrections Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 12302, is
12 currently treated in the City and County of Denver’s financial system of record as “sponsor-funded”
13 because the City had classified the prior contracts with the State for this program as “grants”; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the City Attorney’s Office has reviewed the current contract with the State for the
15 Community Corrections program, filed under the City Clerk’s Filing No. 201950810-00, and
16 determined that it meets the City’s criteria for intergovernmental agreements; and

17 **WHEREAS**, to match the classification of the new contract as an intergovernmental
18 agreement, the budget basis of the Community Corrections Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No.
19 12302, must change from “sponsor-funded” to “appropriated;” and

20 **WHEREAS**, the originating ordinance of the Community Corrections Special Revenue Fund,
21 Accounting No. 12302, cannot be located; however, this ordinance shall establish the new budget
22 basis and supersede any prior ordinance language regarding the fund’s budget basis; and

23 **WHEREAS**, the State fiscal year starts on July 1 while the City and Count of Denver’s fiscal
24 year starts on January 1;

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**
26 **DENVER:**

27 **Section 1.** The proposed Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and County of
28 Denver and State of Colorado, in the words and figures contained and set forth in that form of
29 Intergovernmental Agreement available in the office and on the web page of City Council, and filed
30 in the office of the Clerk and Recorder, Ex-Officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, under City
31 Clerk's Filing No. 201950810-00, is hereby approved.

1 **Section 2.** The Community Corrections Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 12302, in the
2 Public Safety Special Revenue Fund Series, Accounting No. 12000, shall henceforth be treated as
3 an appropriated, lapsing fund.

4 **Section 3.** From the Community Corrections Fund, Accounting No. 12302, out of monies not
5 otherwise appropriated and in addition to the amounts heretofore appropriated by Ordinance No.
6 1280, Series of 2018, and any supplemental appropriations or rescissions there is hereby
7 appropriated to the appropriation account hereinafter designated the amounts of money following
8 each such designation, to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said
9 Ordinance set forth:

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11 The above appropriation represents half of the contract value and therefore supports the Community
12 Corrections program through the remainder of the City and County of Denver’s fiscal year. The
13 remaining value of the FY2019-2020 contract shall be included in Denver’s 2020 Annual
14 Appropriation Ordinance. Henceforth, all subsequent appropriations will be made in Denver’s Annual
15 Appropriation Ordinance or other ordinances as may be needed.

16 **Section 4.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized
17 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary
18 to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
