CITY COUNCIL ORDINANCE REQUEST SUMMARY

Public Art CEP Concourse B-West Expansion Site

Purpose and Use of Agreement(s)

A community-based selection panel made up of community representatives, civic leaders, arts and cultural professionals has selected artist Kipp Kobayashi of Claremont, CA, to create a suspended artwork to be placed within the circulation space of the newly constructed Concourse B-West expansion at Denver International Airport (DEN). The project is part of the City's Public Art Program and procured through 1%-For-Art funds as part of the Concourse Expansion Program at DEN.

The sculpture will be created from stainless-steel welded mesh titled, *The Cosmology of Flight*. The sculpture will be approx. 140' L x 25' W x 20' H. The artwork which is inspired by scale, perception and size will activate the center circulation space of the newly constructed Concourse B-West expansion with a life-sized 767 aircraft. The translucent sculpture will allow passengers the uncommon view an airplane up-close to appreciate the modern marvel of air travel.

Public art contract for the design, fabrication and installation of two original suspended sculptures within the Concourse B-West expansion at DEN with artist Kipp Kobayashi, 3-year term with the option of (2) 1-year extensions, maximum contract amount of \$2,500,000.00.
