HFDK's support will allow FrontLine farming to create expanded educational opportunities to youth in their target areas. The expanded programming activities will include a minimum of 20 educational presentations for youth with a focus on ages 0-5, monthly on-site garden classes, the creation of a community garden with programming at an anchor institution for the Black community in Denver, and additional staffing to enroll and directly connect families to Federal Nutrition Assistance Programs. They will also be able to engage small children with nutritious food by providing healthy snacks and meals at youth classes. The target audience is children, families and ECE staff. FLF propose to create an intersectional, farm-based curriculum for youth across Denver, through which youth will be taught how to access diverse and healthy foodways.
