Government & Finance

- BR12- Approves a title and pay grade change for Classification #1375 from 0981 Pool Supervisor to Pool Coordinator.
- BR12- Approves the sale of a community center located at 809 South 0982 Washington Street to the Washington Street Community Center Inc., a Colorado nonprofit corporation and current tenant that has exercised their option to purchase the center under the terms of an existing lease.
- BR12- Approves a Master Purchase Order with Network Infrastructure Support 0987 Services for a maximum of \$25,000,000 for equipment, software, and professional service purchases to support the City's data and voice network (MPO 0643A0113).

Health, Safety, Education & Services

- RR12- Approves the Mayoral reappointment of Erin Binford to the Head Start 0979 Policy Council for a term effective immediately and expiring on July 20, 2013 or until a successor is duly appointed.
- RR12- Approves the Mayoral reappointment of Paula Sandoval to the Board of 0978 Environmental Health for a term effective immediately and expiring on December 31, 2017 or until a successor is duly appointed.
- BR12- Approves the purchase of three body scanners for a total of \$750,000 to 0984 be used at the Downtown Detention Center and County Jail facilities for the safety of the inmates, officers, and the public.

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

- RR12- Approves the Mayoral reappointments of Laura Aldrete, William Bianco, 0980 Jerrold Glick, and Michael West to the Denver Union Station Project Authority Board of Directors for a term effective immediately and

expiring December 31, 2014 or until a successor is duly appointed.

RR12- Accepts the Subdivision Plat for Stapleton Filing No. 39 for public right-of-way and infrastructure at the northeast corner of Central Park Blvd. and Interstate 70 in Council District 11.

BR12- Approves purchase of 61 police motorcycles from Avalanche Harley 0986 Davidson for \$686,370.17, or \$11,251.97 each (PWOPS55091).

Councilmembers receive the consent agendas for review and have until Thursday at noon to request that an item be scheduled for Committee discussion.
