Third Amendment to RMES Communications, Inc., Payphone Agreement

- The Third Amendment will terminate the Agreement AR54006 for payphone service between the City and County of Denver and RMES Communication, Inc., as of September 30, 2012 at Denver International Airport
- All phone operations and equipment sites at DIA under the existing RMES Communications, Inc., Agreement will transition to the new Clear Channel Airports Agreement, PLANE-201205012
 - RMES Communications, Inc. (Herman Malone) will become the ACDBE partner of Clear Channel

Benefits

- Change results in provision of free domestic telephone service at DIA and up to ten free minutes of international service
- Improved customer service for traveling public at Denver International Airport
- Greater convenience, notable cost burden elimination, and improved courtesy service provision
- In the long-term, the overall change is also a potential additional revenue source for the current airport-wide Clear Channel advertising contract
