Contract amendment would allow for continuity of the agreement which was originally established in 2009 between Knowledge Computing Corporation (KCC), product developer/provider of the COPLINK suite of law enforcement software, and the Denver Police Department.

KCC later began doing-business-as I2; which was subsequently acquired by IBM in 2012. IBM has now completed the integration of I2 and will no longer be accepting payments made payable to I2 and/or KCC.

The existing contract defines provision of maintenance of the COPLINK program and has a term through 09/30/2015. No changes to the terms and conditions are being proposed by this amendment.
