A BILL

For an ordinance naming the park at 3200 East 52nd Avenue as “Lorraine Granado Community Park”.

WHEREAS, the City County of Denver acquired the land on which a park sits, sometimes known as “Swansea Neighborhood” Park, City and County of Denver, in 2001, located at approximately 3200 East 52nd Avenue, Denver, Colorado 80216; and

WHEREAS, the park was fully designated in accordance with City Charter in 2014; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the procedure established by the Department of Parks and Recreation’s Naming Policy, submitted a proposal to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board to name the park at 3200 52nd Avenue “Lorraine Granado Community Park”; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the naming is in recognition of a significant gift from and on behalf of Lorraine Granado, as well as to recognize Lorraine Granado as an exceptional and important person to the Swansea neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the Manager of the Department of Parks and Recreation supports the proposed naming of this park; and

WHEREAS, the Denver Parks and Recreation Advisory Board voted at its meeting on December 11, 2019, to recommend the naming of the park at 3200 52nd Avenue as “Lorraine Granado Community Park”.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That the park at 3200 52nd Avenue be and the same is hereby named, and shall be known as, LORRAINE GRANADO COMMUNITY PARK.

Section 2. That this action shall be effective upon the final adoption of the ordinance.
