7 **For an ordinance authorizing a capital equipment purchase from the Denver**  
8 **Human Services Special Revenue Fund (SRF 13008).**

10 **WHEREAS**, Denver Human Services (DHS) is seeking approval for a capital equipment  
11 purchase of a replacement pickup truck with lift bed to support various agency needs including  
12 delivery and relocation of items, furniture, and food for client service programs; and

13 **WHEREAS**, said vehicle will replace an older truck that is beyond its useful life, creating  
14 maintenance challenges due to costs and parts availability; and

15 **WHEREAS**, said vehicle will be stored in the security-controlled garage of the Richard T.  
16 Castro Building campus located at 1200 Federal Boulevard; and

17 **WHEREAS**, said replacement vehicle is approved to be purchased from the Denver Human  
18 Services Special Revenue Fund (13008); and

19 **WHEREAS**, because this is a capital equipment purchase above the fifty-thousand-dollar  
20 threshold, DHS requires City Council authorization to purchase said vehicle;

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY**

25 **Section 1.** From the Denver Human Services Special Revenue Fund (13008), the Chief  
26 Financial Officer, or duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the  
27 following capital equipment:
