1. Amend Ordinance Number 426, Series of 2007 and subsequent amendments thereto as identified above with a final reconciling reallocation of project funds within existing Better Denver Bond Program as further described below.

Purpose 2

- Boettcher Concert Hall – reduce funding from \$3,368,000 to \$1,460,000
- Denver Performing Arts Complex – increase funding from \$5,400,000 to \$7,308,000.

Purpose 4

- Parkfield Lake Park – reduce funding from \$10,995,000 to \$10,895,000
- Central Denver Recreation Center – increase funding from \$11,000,000 to \$11,100,000.

Purpose 6

- California Street (14th to 20th St.) – reduce funding from \$2,077,000 to \$1,925,000
- 38th Avenue Underpass – reduce funding from \$2,588,000 to \$2,187,000
- Peoria Street Grade Separation – reduce funding from \$1,667,000 to \$1,445,000
- 38th and Blake Station Infrastructure – increase funding from \$4,523,000 to \$11,100,000.

- Boettcher Concert Hall – reduce funding from \$3,806,000 to \$1,390,000
- DPAC Champa Street Bridge – Delete project and reduce funding from \$2,500,000 to \$0
- Levitt Pavilion Amphitheater at Ruby Hill – increase funding from \$2,000,000 to \$2,900,000
- Denver Performing Arts Complex – increase funding from \$5,475,000 to \$8,491,000
- Denver Center for Performing Arts, Bonfils – Add new project for \$1,000,0000.
