A BILL

For an ordinance approving a proposed Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Denver Urban Renewal Authority to fund construction of the two-way street conversion relating to the St. Luke's Urban Redevelopment Area.

WHEREAS, ordinance 667, series 1996 established the St. Luke's Urban Development Plan and created the St. Luke's sales and property tax increment areas; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Intergovernmental Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Denver Urban Renewal Authority ("DURA"), in the words and figures contained and set forth in that form of Intergovernmental Agreement available in the office and on the web page of City Council, and filed in the office of the Clerk and Recorder, Ex-Officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, under City Clerk's Filing No. 16-0474, is hereby approved.

Section 2. The payments made pursuant to the proposed Intergovernmental Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 38000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said project is as follows:
