Projected Economic Benefits

- Program's projected gross revenue: \$13 M in Year 1
- Sales tax to the City: approximately \$500,000
- Estimating 120 new jobs at time of grand opening
- Airport Concessions Disadvantaged Business Enterprise goal is 25%

Airport Benefits

- Approximately \$13 million projected in additional Sales
- \$1 million or greater annual rent to airport
 - Helps meet airport mandate to maximize non airline revenue
- Expanded retail choices for customers
 - Seasonal and non-seasonal merchandise
 - Automated retail in certain locations
