

## **Committee Consent Agenda**

Thursday, August 11, 2011

## **Government & Finance**

- BR11- Amends the Classification and Pay Plan by 1) adding Forensic Laboratory Technician, Special Education Teaching Assistant and Special Education Teaching Assistant Supervisor; 2) changing pay grades of Deputy City Attorney and Deputy Manager of Parks & Recreation; and 3) changing title and pay grade of Director of the Mayor's Office of Economic Development to Director of the Denver Office of Economic Development.
- BR11- Approves annual Insurance Policy Renewals for the City and DIA in an amount not to exceed \$4,354,438, the amount anticipated for 2011.
- BR11- Amends the contract with Kone Inc. for City-owned elevator preventative maintenance and emergency services to extend for 2 years and add \$316,635 for a new total of \$752,000 over 5 years, define emergency and clarify travel time to and from job sites.

## **Health, Safety, Education & Services**

- BR11- Approves a no-cost 1-year extension, as allowed by contract, to the contract with Bureau Veritas North America, Inc. for remediation and groundwater monitoring.
- BR11- Accepts \$1,040,491.22 awarded to Denver Human Services under the FY 2011-2012 Community Service Block Grant program.

## **Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure**

- BR11- Approves an Intergovernmental Agreement reimbursing the Colorado Department of Transportation for work performed on "Central Street Promenade" in Council District 9.
- BR11- Approves an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Colorado

- Department of Transportation allowing the City to receive and expend \$1,510,000 in first-phase funding for construction of the pedestrian bridge over I-25 near the Colorado Center transit stop in Council District 6.
- BR11- Establishes a capital grant fund and appropriates budget of \$3,532,000 for the Broadway reconstruction project from Iowa to Asbury in Council District 7.
- RR11- Grants a revocable permit to the US General Services Administration ARRA to encroach into the public right-of-way with a retaining wall and building elements at 1244 Speer; solar sculpture canopy, garage entry canopy and screen, and foundation shoring at 1300 Fox; and 6 electric conduits below grade crossing 13th Ave. to connect the two buildings in Council District 10.

Routine, non-controversial requests for ordinances that are not substantive policy changes may be placed on Consent Agendas for Council Committees each week with the approval of Committee chairs. Councilmembers receive the consent agendas for review and have until Thursday at noon to request that an item be scheduled for Committee discussion. If approved, items are placed on the Mayor-Council agenda the following week. This document outlines the items that were placed on consent agendas this week.
