	The ordinance provides access via a License Agreement to the Park Creek Metropolitan District and Forest City Stapleton onto city-owned property in Stapleton south of 56 <sup>th</sup> Avenue and west of Dallas Street. These parties will construct a drainage pond and a sanitary pipeline to serve the Stapleton High School site, which will be built by DPS over the next few years. The License Agreement does not include any monetary exchanges – it simply grants access and clarifies that the District will assume maintenance responsibilities for the infrastructure they construct until these improvements are accepted by the city and the warranty period ends. The land in the License Agreement is categorized "Trunk Open Space" and will eventually become a city park.
