General Services is undertaking a \$2M Energy Performance Contract which involves the implementation of facility improvements that will result in energy savings and supports citywide sustainability goals. Improvements will be completed in 14 buildings including several fire stations, police district stations, recreation centers, and libraries. Improvements include lighting controls, pool covers, building envelope improvements, etc. These improvements will take place in 2016. The improvements will be funded via a \$2M loan from the Environmental Services Enterprise Fund (ESEF) to be repaid over the term of 15 years from savings generated in the General Fund Utilities Budget. The estimated savings to be generated on an annual basis is guaranteed by the vendor, Ameresco. The annual repayment to the ESEF will be appropriated during each year's budget process. In accordance with accounting guidelines, the \$2M in funding from the ESEF will need to pass-through the General Fund to the Capital Improvement Fund in order to allow for the repayment to ESEF from General Fund Utilities Budget savings.
