A BILL

For an ordinance amending Ordinance No. 113 Series of 1985 to update outdated language and to authorize expenditures above \$1,500 without requiring City Council approval.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 113 Series of 1985 amended Special Revenue Fund No. 15704, the “Human Rights and Community Relations” Special Revenue Fund, to require City Council Approval on expenditures above \$1,500; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance was last updated in 1985 and contains outdated language that is not consistent with other Special Revenue Funds; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to remove the outdated expenditure requirement and update the ordinance language to align with current standards;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That portion of Section 2 and 3 of Ordinance 113, Series of 1985, are hereby further amended to read as follows:

“Section 2. Program expenditures are hereby authorized for the “Human Rights and Community Relations” Fund, Accounting No.15704 to be expended by the Executive Director of Human Right and Community Partnerships, the amount not to exceed deposits in Section 1. Allowable expenditures include the purchase of equipment, furniture and supplies, and services provided in connection with programs and events of the Agency for Human Rights and Community Partnerships individual commissions. This Fund is revenue-based and non-lapsing.

Section 3. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.”
