EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This ordinance approves the 9th and Colorado Urban Redevelopment Plan authorizing the creation of an Urban Redevelopment Area and the use of tax increment financing.

The Plan makes the required statutory findings for the creation of an Urban Renewal Area, including a finding of blight. Additionally, the Plan has been found to be in conformance with the City's Comprehensive Plan. This conformance will be represented by a finding of the Denver Planning Board. The Plan lays out objectives for revitalizing the Urban Redevelopment Area. In addition, the Plan authorizes DURA to undertake projects using tax increment financing (TIF) to achieve those objectives, subject to City Council approval of one or more tax increment areas.

The primary objectives of the Plan are to reduce or eliminate blighted conditions as well as to stimulate the growth and development of the Area to allow for the redevelopment of the area with mixed uses, which may include residential, office, retail, and/or commercial.

The Denver Urban Renewal Authority, in coordination with the City's Department of Finance and Department of Community Planning and Development, is seeking to establish an Urban Redevelopment Area to support the proposed development through the approval of an Urban Redevelopment Plan. Staff with the City and DURA have agreed to an Urban Redevelopment Plan and Cooperation Agreement authorizing the creation of the 9th and Colorado Redevelopment Area and the use of tax increment financing by DURA, subject to City Council Approval.

DURA will be making an informational presentation regarding the Urban Redevelopment Plan and the related Cooperation Agreement at the Council Committee meeting on June 4, 2013. A formal presentation, seeking Council Committee approval is requested for June 25, 2013.
