The Department of Transportation and Infrastructure (DOTI) is seeking approval for a capital equipment purchase of six sweepers. Six dump trucks were authorized in the annual Long Bill ordinance 1539, series of 2024, however, DOTI wishes to acquire sweepers instead of the previously approved dump trucks due to a greater need for sweepers. As a result, DOTI is requesting this swap. The sweepers will not be electric vehicles (EVs), as there are currently no EV options that meet the city's requirements. However, a hybrid option is available, and DOTI plans to order one of the hybrids for a pilot test.
