A BILL

For an ordinance establishing a "Public Works Alternative Fuel Vehicles Donation" fund in the General Government Special Revenue Fund and the means for authorizing expenditures from such fund.

WHEREAS, the City desires to increase the use of alternative fuel vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the City has received a private donation that would assist in the replacement of heavy vehicles within Public Work's fleet with vehicles that run on compressed natural gas (CNG); and

WHEREAS, the City needs time to establish the necessary infrastructure, including a CNG fueling station;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. There is hereby established in the General Government Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 11000, a "Public Works Alternative Fuel Vehicles Donation" fund, Accounting No. 11606-5011101, for the purpose of accepting donations to fund alternative fuel vehicles in Public Works and handling financial transactions related to the alternative fuel vehicle program.

Section 2. Monies received from private donations, reimbursements, or other sources of private receipts shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 11000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. Expenditures for the purchase of CNG vehicles shall not be approved until after the City has selected a vendor for the construction of the CNG fueling station and fuel through an appropriate competitive selection process. Upon award of the contract to construct the CNG fueling station to an approved vendor, the Manager of Public Works may begin expenditures from the "Public Works Alternative Fuel Vehicles Donations" fund, Accounting No. 11606-5011101, in an amount not to exceed the total of deposits described in Section 2 of this Ordinance. Authorized expenditures may include the incremental cost of purchasing CNG vehicles over traditional fuel vehicles and other incidental costs associated with the alternative fuel vehicle program.

1 **Section 4.** The Manager of Finance of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized
2 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be
3 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
