A BILL

For an ordinance rescinding budget from Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Projects and making appropriations for Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Projects.

WHEREAS the City desires to rescind budget from the completed Yale/Syracuse project to fund pedestrian safety improvements in the Yale corridor to be constructed in coordination with the E. Yale Stormwater project and Yale and Dahlia signal replacement project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From appropriations heretofore made from the Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Fund listed or indicated in the following tabulation there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount Rescinded" and transferred to the Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Fund:
