On-Call Golf Course Restoration, Repair and Improvement Services

Purpose and Use of Agreements:

The purpose of this agreement is to establish an on-call contract for small-scale golf course renovation services, repairs, and improvements services at the eight City and County of Denver municipal golf courses and facilities.

Procurement:

DPR issued a request for proposals for this on-call contract on June 8th 2023, Colorado Designscapes was the only firm that submitted a proposal, after review of the proposal from Colorado Designscapes it was determined that the proposal met the requirements of the RFP and the selection committee determined to move forward with the contract.

Description for Request:

Golf has eight (8) facilities to operate and maintain and there is a need to perform continuous maintenance and improvements to keep facilities operational, and provide the best experience for patrons. This on-call contract will allow golf to make necessary repairs and improvements to facilities utilizing an on-call contractor. Work may include, but is not limited to:

- Sod removal, tilling of topsoil, rock grading, and debris removal of localized areas in fairways and rough
- Sod installation using big roll and standard roll sizes
- Tee renovation including sod removal, laser leveling crowned tee surfaces, and sod replacement
- Minor grade reshaping of bunkers and other golf course surfaces
- Working with and around existing irrigation
- Sod restoration and regrading after minor damaging events such as tire ruts, flooding, or other events that are too significant for in-house repair but not rising to the level of major renovation or construction
- Hauling organic debris generated from renovation
- Drainage installation

This contract does not commit funds, nor does it guarantee any amount to the firms. This contract is not an authorization of work. Authorization of work and commitment of funds are made via work order on an as needed basis.
