This ordinance approves a grant agreement amendment with Denver Neighborhood Revitalization, Inc. (DNRI) to correct the CFDA Number, modify the number of units to be developed, delete land banking as an eligible activity, define program income vs. program revenue, expand eligible neighborhoods, and modify line items in the budget. This contract was originally executed on August 18, 2009 and was a part of the Neighborhood Stabilization Program funding Denver received through the Housing and Economic Recovery Act (HERA) of 2008. HERA originally established the NSP and appropriated funds to address the effects of abandoned and foreclosed properties in the nation’s communities.
