The Transformational Homelessness Response (THR) grant program (the “Program”) aims to quickly connect people experiencing homelessness with services, treatment, and temporary and permanent housing to put them on a path to economic self-sufficiency. The Program provides funding for program models and activities including outreach support, emergency shelters, transitional housing, recovery care and related residential programs, training and employment service programs, and permanent housing with wraparound supportive services. The Program also provides funding for systems improvement activities including data collection, management, analysis, system integration, coordination, and resource utilization acceleration. The goal of the Program is to fundamentally shift the landscape of homelessness in communities across Colorado by transforming systems, programs, and outcomes. Grant awards must go beyond maintaining current operations for projects that currently exist while being responsive to the one-time nature of the funding provided.
