DPR was awarded a grant from Great Outdoors Colorado (GOCO), under which Denver Youth Program (GRASP) is a third-party beneficiary. GRASP will use grant funds to deliver career pathway programs, including the Youth Parks Guide initiative, which fosters stewardship of the City's natural resources while providing a safe, supportive environment for local youth. GRASP also offers leadership opportunities through its Youth Advisory and Action Council, where teens collaborate with coalition partners to inform and guide coalition initiatives, programs, and decisions. In addition, GRASP serves as the "HUB" for the My Outdoor Colorado coalition, overseeing the Coalition Coordinator role, Community Connectors, and Family Nature Club programs. This is to reduce funding on this contract (reduce the contract total amount). This is an expenditure agreement with a contract total of \$1,205,710.63. We want to reduce it by \$152,424.75 and reallocate those funds to other coalition partners for needed services before the grant period ends. New contract total should be \$1,053,285.88.
