A BILL

**For an ordinance amending Article II of Chapter 6 to repeal the sunset date for entertainment districts.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** That section 6-23 of the Code shall be amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined, to read as follows:

**Sec. 6-23. - ~~Sunset;~~ Report to city council.**

~~(a) This article II shall be effectively repealed five (5) years after the effective date of the ordinance.~~

~~(b)~~ The director shall report in writing to city council by April 15 of each year, ~~beginning in 2024,~~ on the operation of the entertainment district and common consumption area licensing program.
