This amendment adds project Tranche 5 to the 25-year Master Operator Agreement with McKinstry Essention, LLC, for the design, development, installation, operation, and maintenance of community solar photovoltaic generating facilities and electric vehicle chargers owned by the City as part of the Renewable Denver Community Solar Initiative. Project Tranche 5 is for four (4) community solar projects totaling approximately 1,150 kWdc of solar capacity. The project adds DPS East High School (district 10), DPS GW High School (district 5), DPS South High School (district 6), and the Urban Land Conservancy Foundry rooftop (district 3) to the Renewable Denver Community Solar portfolio and the City's collaborative partnership with Denver Public Schools. 100% of the bill credits generated from this array will be donated to lower the utility bills of approximately 200 low-income DPS families in need spanning all city council districts. Additionally, the project will provide community engagement and offer incentives for green workforce initiatives.  CASR continues to submit applications to Xcel Energy to approve additional solar projects across the city for Denver's solar portfolio. The above project represents projects seventeen to twenty in the Renewable Denver Community Solar Initiative.
