11	WHEREAS, the Honorable Elbra Wedgeworth is a proud East Denver native, and her	
12	professional experience in the private/public sector spans 26 years; and

14	WHEREAS, in 1999 Elbra Wedgeworth was elected as the City Councilwoman for District	
15	15 8 ; and

17	17 WHEREAS, in 2003 when the City County of Denver was to experience the gr	eatest
18	turnover in its government since 1904 due to term limitations, Elbra Wedgeworth was elected to	
19	serve a second four-year term as the District 8 representative unopposed, and she provided the	
20	dedicated leadership needed for a smooth transition for the newly elected officials who took office	
21	21 in 2003; and

23	23 WHEREAS, Elbra Wedgeworth's City Council colleagues unanimously elected	d her the
24	24 Council President for 2003-2005, during which time she oversaw the multimillion doll	ar city council
25	25 budget, revised the council rules and completely restructured the council committees	; and

27	27 WHEREAS , during Elbra Wedgeworth's tenure on City Council, she oversaw to	ihe
28	28 renaissance of Council District 8 through various projects, including the redevelopme	nt of East

30	30 Authority, Skyline Park Renovation, Hyatt Regency Convention Center Hotel, Colorad	do Convention

WHEREAS, Elbra Wedgeworth served as the President/Chair of the Denver 2008 Convention Host Committee for the historic Democratic National Convention; her leadership was crucial and key to Denver being chosen to host the Convention; the 2008 Convention was the largest convention in the history of the City of Denver and the State of Colorado; the Host Committee raised funds and in-kind donations of more than \$135 million; the Convention itself generated more than \$266.0 million dollars in economic benefit; and Elbra Wedgeworth will be remembered as the first African-American woman to be President/Chair of a Host Committee in the history of either political party; and

WHEREAS, in 2013, *5280 Magazine* named Elbra Wedgeworth as a woman of Colorado who has played a historically significant role because of chiefly being responsible for bringing the 2008 Democratic National Convention to Denver; and

WHEREAS, in April of 2012, Elbra Wedgeworth was named by the Denver Post as One of Colorado's Most Influential Women and was named one of Denver's 25 Most Powerful women by the Colorado Women's Chamber of Commerce and also receiving their ATHENA Award which honors Colorado women who best exemplify exceptional professional achievement, devotion to community service, and assisting other women in the attainment of professional excellence and leadership skills; and

WHEREAS, in 2014, Elbra was inducted into the "Blacks in Colorado" Hall of Fame by the Denver Public Library; and

WHEREAS, in April 2007, Elbra Wedgeworth became the Chief Government and Community Relations Officer at Denver Health and Hospital Authority where she is responsible for all governmental legislative matters on the local, state and federal level and is the hospital's liaison for Community Outreach Initiatives; and

WHEREAS, in September 2008, Elbra Wedgeworth was elected unanimously as the President of the Denver Union Station Project Authority Board of Directors and is serving her 6th term as the Board President; and

1	WHEREAS, Elbra Wedgeworth currently serves as the Chairwoman for the Downtown
2	Denver Partnership Inc., the first person of color male or female to serve as Chairperson in the
3	Partnership's 58 year history; and
4	
5	WHEREAS, Elbra Wedgeworth also serves as a member to the Metro Regional Council for
6	the El Pomar Regional Partnerships Program; and
7	
8	WHEREAS, Section 2-275 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code sets forth the procedures
9	and criteria for naming City-owned buildings; a petition has been submitted to the Council pursuant
10	to the Code proposing that the building located at 2855 Tremont Place should be named in honor
11	of Elbra M. Wedgeworth; and the City Council has determined that Elbra M. Wedgeworth is an
12	outstanding Denver resident who was and is influential in the cultural, political, economic and
13	social life of the community for the reasons set forth above.
14	
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF
16	DENVER:

18	Section 1. The City-owned property at 2855 Tremont Place shall henceforth be named the
19	Elbra M. Wedgeworth Municipal Building.
