Arbitration Fee Schedule

A per diem fee of \$1,100 is charged for each day of travel, hearing, research and writing time devoted to any arbitration. Expenses (transportation, meals and lodging, where applicable) are billed at cost. A CANCELLATION FEE of \$1100 is charged for each scheduled day of travel and hearing if the hearing is canceled or postponed less than two months prior to the scheduled hearing date. Non-refundable expenses (such as airline change fees) are billed if they have been incurred prior to notification of cancellation. However, such expenses usually are not incurred more than 30 days prior to the scheduled

hearing.
